First class passenger train. Stops at West Alton (5 minutes), Old Monroe (5 minutes), Elsberry (5 minutes), Clarksville (5 minutes), Louisiana (5 minutes), Hannibal (30 minutes), and West Quincy (20 minutes). Sets out baggage car at West Quincy.

CB&Q 691 Lv West Alton 5:00pm Terminates Hannibal
Third class local freight. Works Old Monroe, Elsberry, Clarksville, and Louisiana. Check with West Alton yardmaster to confirm train is made up and ready to depart.

CB&Q 44 Lv West Quincy 5:40pm Terminates St. Louis
First class passenger train. Stops West Quincy, Hannibal (20 minutes), Louisiana (10 minutes), Clarksville (5 minutes), Elsberry (5 minutes), Old Monroe (5 minutes) and West Alton (5 minutes).

MKT 53 Lv St. Louis 7:00pm Terminates Franklin (Machens)
Second class through freight. Stops at West Alton yard for switching. Hold at West Alton until MKT 76 arrives.
